For the **first class**,

- Paints: all you need to bring is Cadmium Red, Cadmium Yellow, and Winsor Blue
- Some brushes
- Watercolor paper (I use Fabriano 140 lbs., cold press)

Miscellaneous:

- 2 small plastic containers for water
- Small lightweight board (I use a piece of masonite) to which to attach watercolor paper,
cut slightly bigger than the size paper you will be using
- Bull dog clips (to attach paper to board)
- 2B Drawing pencils
- Kneaded eraser
- Clean sponge

For the rest of the class

I get most of my supplies (paints, brushes, paper) online, either at www.ArtSuppliesOnline.com or www.cheapjoes.com or <http://www.pearlpaint.com> If I need supplies quickly, I go either to Pearl Arts and Crafts or to Artist and Craftsman Supply, two stores across the street from each other on Mass Ave. in Central Square, Cambridge.

Paints:

You should buy tube paints, either Holbein (easier to keep moist) or Winsor Newton. [Winsor Newton's Cotman paint—is a lower grade; DO NOT BUY. Also--do not buy tubes marked "hue" as they contain less pigment]

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The colors I use are:

Cadmium yellow light

Cadmium yellow deep

Cadmium red

Alizarin Crimson (the Holbein equivalent color is Carmine)

Yellow Ocher
