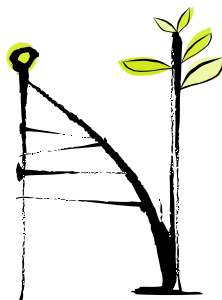

Welcome to the New Art Center!

Our popular summer programs for children and teens provide students with the opportunity to try a variety of art mediums and develop new skills in a fun, safe and supportive environment, bringing families back year after year.

Children's Program:

Groups of 15 children of the same grade/age stay together all week, led by their counselors. Each class is led by a professional art instructor and also assisted by a teen-aged counselor. Students attend four classes daily: Drawing/Painting, Sculpture/3D, Ceramics, and Activities/Drama. Students also enjoy snack, lunch and outdoor play time. Each week, students create and bring home exciting projects inspired by our fun and creative themes!

Teen Program:

Teens stay together in their groups of 7 for the day. They work in Painting/Drawing, Sculpture/Mixed Media and Ceramics with 2 professional art educators who help the teens develop and hone their skills.

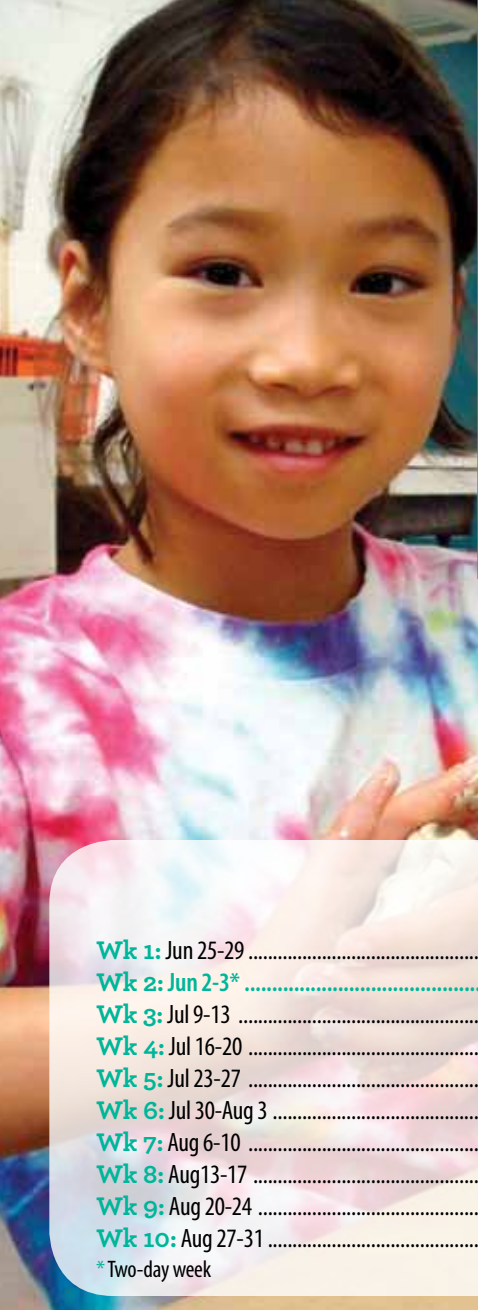
Children's Class Descriptions.....

Painting/Drawing: Our experienced faculty introduce projects inspired by the weekly theme, and students sketch ideas and designs. As the week progresses, students build on their drawing or painting to make a beautiful completed piece.

Sculpture/3D: Students work with papier-mâché, plaster, or cardboard to create a unique sculpture inspired by our theme. The first few days are spent creating the basic structure of the sculpture, followed by papier-mâché or plaster to stabilize the form, and lastly they paint and decorate their fantastic creations!

Ceramics: Students use hand-building techniques with red clay to sculpt a figure or object inspired by the week's theme. Once the sculptures are dry, students glaze their work and prepare them to be fired in the kiln. On Thursday students create a second project with white, self-hardening clay and paint them on Friday!

Drama/Activities: Students play drama games related to the week's theme. Improv games such as "charades" and other exciting activities give children a chance to think creatively and have fun! Each week, one age group creates a skit to perform at Friday's Exhibition at 3:00pm.

Snack/Lunch: Each day, groups meet together for a 20-minute snack, and a 55-minute lunch/recess time. These fun breaks give the students time to unwind, socialize and eat. Supervised recess is held outside, weather permitting. Children bring their own snack and lunch. *Note, we cannot refrigerate anything, but we can heat it up!

Mid-Day Break: Students have another 15-minute break in the mid-afternoon to unwind, get water, and stretch out before their last class of the day!

Outdoor Time: Students have about 45 minutes outside, for a variety of games and activities, weather permitting. The NAC driveway is blocked off on both ends and students play in the shaded area.

Special Presentation: Some weeks, the New Art Center offers special theme-related presentations. Past presentations have included visits from the Museum of Science, Zoo New England, and Mexican dancers, Indian drummers and other very special events! *Check website for additions to weekly presentations offerings!

Week 8: Incredible Ireland AUGUST 13-17 - CS124243

Discover the charm of Ireland! This week, we'll learn about Ireland's rich history in the arts including sculpture, painting, metalwork, music, dance and more! Paint or draw Ireland's panoramic vistas, reproduce ancient bronze artifacts, and create other artworks inspired by the beauty and mystery of the Emerald Isle!

Week 9: Lost Civilizations AUGUST 20-24 - CS124244

All around the world, archeologists find mysterious clues to ancient lost civilizations. Recreate important architectural structures like pyramids, bridges, and temples. Paint and sculpt imaginative scenes of cities, landscapes and people, and hear stories from these extraordinary ancient places.

Week 10: Cirque du Soleil AUGUST 27-31 - CS124245

Discover the multi-disciplinary beauty of art this week, and be inspired by the enchanting Cirque du Soleil. Blending art from around the world, fantastical characters and performance, we'll imagine and create artworks based on this popular circus show. From colorful paintings and drawings to figurative character sculptures and theater games, it will be one fascinating week!

MORNING AND LATE AFTERNOON

Early Drop-Off - 8:00 - 9:00 am • \$10 Per Child/Per Day
Play games, read stories and listen to music with friends before the full day program begins. You may drop off at any time between 8:00 - 9:00 am.

Extended Day - 3:30 - 5:30 pm • \$20 Per Child/Per Day
Consists of games, stories, and additional art projects. Children will have the option for a nut-free snack provided by the New Art Center. Children in Extended Day sometimes cross the street to the grassy area Washington Park under the supervision of an NAC faculty member and a counselor.

Teen Summer Art Programs

Day Program Overview

HOURS: 9:00AM-3:30PM • GRADES 7-10

TUITION: \$380 PER WEEK • SIBLINGS: \$360 PER WEEK

Designed for students who love art and want to move to the next level, the Teen Day Program allows creative freedom and individualized instruction. Throughout the week, two small groups of 7 teens stay together while splitting their day between work in Visual Arts and Ceramics. Teens work with one instructor in Painting/Drawing, and Sculpture/Mixed Media, then move to work with another instructor in Ceramics Handbuilding and Wheel Throwing. Our professional art instructors help each teen develop and hone their skills, working with each student at his or her own pace. Students of all skill levels are welcome!

Lunch

Teens have an hour to eat lunch and take a break during the day. Teens with a signed "Permission to Leave the Premises" form are allowed to walk to Newtonville to purchase lunch or eat lunch they've brought. Teens are not supervised by an adult at this time. If a teen does not have a signed permission form, he or she must remain on the New Art Center premises.

Afternoon Teen Ceramics Overview

HOURS: 3:30PM-5:30PM • GRADES 7-10

TUITION: \$115 PER WEEK • SIBLINGS: \$105 PER WEEK

This afternoon Ceramics-intensive course gives teens the chance to experiment and develop their skills in handbuilding and on the Potter's Wheel. Each week, teens will complete projects that are fired and ready for pick up 2-3 weeks after attending the program.

Program Policies

Registration: All registrations are taken on a first come, first-served basis. Full payment* is due May 1, 2012. After May 1, full payment is due with all registrations.
***Non-Refundable Deposits:** A non-refundable deposit of \$100 per week is required at the time of registration for each student, though full payment may also be made. This deposit is non-transferable and will be applied towards your tuition balance.

Withdrawals and Refunds: For withdrawals prior to May 1, payment will be refunded, less the non-refundable deposit of \$100 per week. Registrations withdrawn after May 1, 2012, cannot be refunded. They will be credited toward future classes and programs, less the non-refundable deposit of \$100/wk.

Waiting List: If a week is full at the time of registration, you may request to be put on a waiting list for that week and we will contact you if a space opens up. Call the office at 617-964-3424 for more information.

Confirmations: Confirmations will be sent out during the first week of June. Please make sure to clearly write the best email address to reach you, so you may obtain your confirmation and other important information.

Media Release: New Art Center Programs are sometimes videotaped or photographed for publicity in catalogs, newspapers, radio, or television. Permission to be included in publicity is implied by enrollment. Please contact the office in writing if you do not wish to be included in publicity.

Arrival Time and Pick-Up: The day program begins at 9:00 am. If you would like to drop your child off earlier, please register for Early Drop-Off. Pick-Up is from 3:15-3:30 pm. If you may be late picking your child up, please call the office at 617-964-3424, or your child will be automatically enrolled in Extended Day.

Parking and Access: The New Art Center has a small parking lot located off Madison Avenue. Please follow any signs regarding the flow of traffic during drop-off and pick-up times.

Scholarships: Scholarships are available according to need, on a first-come, first-served basis. Please email Kristi Woodworth at kristi@NewArtCenter.org for an application.

Nuts/Allergies: Due to the prevalence of nut allergies, we encourage you to NOT send lunch or snacks containing nuts with your child. Some weeks will be specified as NUT-FREE weeks. This means no nut products at all may be sent to the New Art Center. Parents will be alerted via email if your child is attending a nut-free week.

Medications: All medications should be checked in with the office staff prior to the start of the week. Children may not keep medication in their backpacks or lunch boxes, and all medications will be administered by a staff person.
